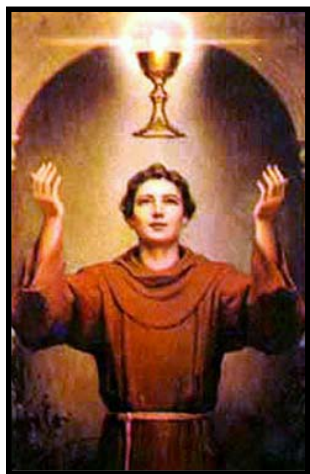

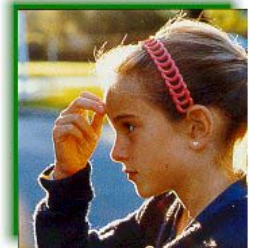
Prayer Corner

Did you know that the Sign of the Cross that we make before and after prayers is also a prayer. That means we should take our time when we make the Sign of the Cross.

To make the Sign of the Cross you should use your right hand. Trace the Cross on your body by touching your forehead for the **Father** the middle of your chest for the **Son**, your left shoulder for **Holy** and your right shoulder

for **Spirit**. The words you say are: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

If you are going into church you can dip your fingers into the Holy Water and then make the Sign of the Cross.
