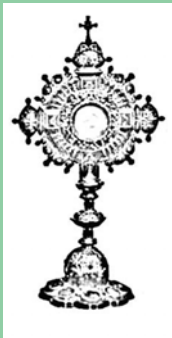

Word of the Month: Monstrance

The Monstrance is a special container that holds the Blessed Sacrament during Adoration. Adoration is a time that you can spend with Jesus. Every church has a Monstrance. Ask your priest and he will show it to you.

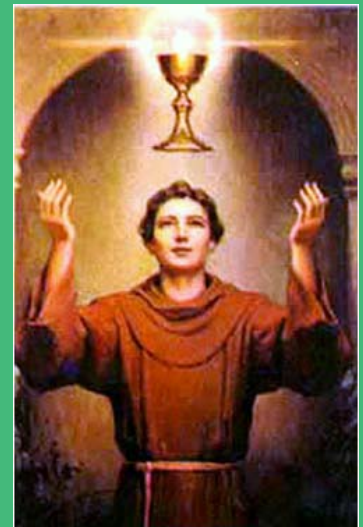

Saint Pascal Baylon

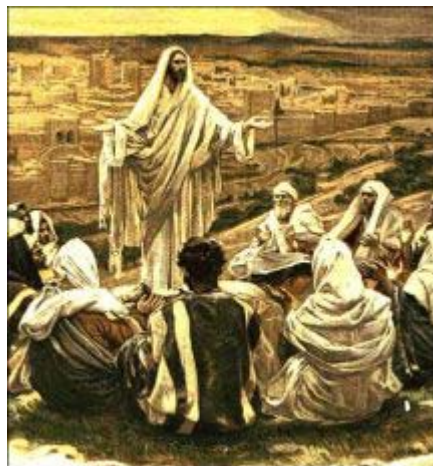
Saint Pascal was born in Spain. As a young boy he looked after the sheep. He would always carry a book with him and beg passerbys to teach him the alphabet and to read.
